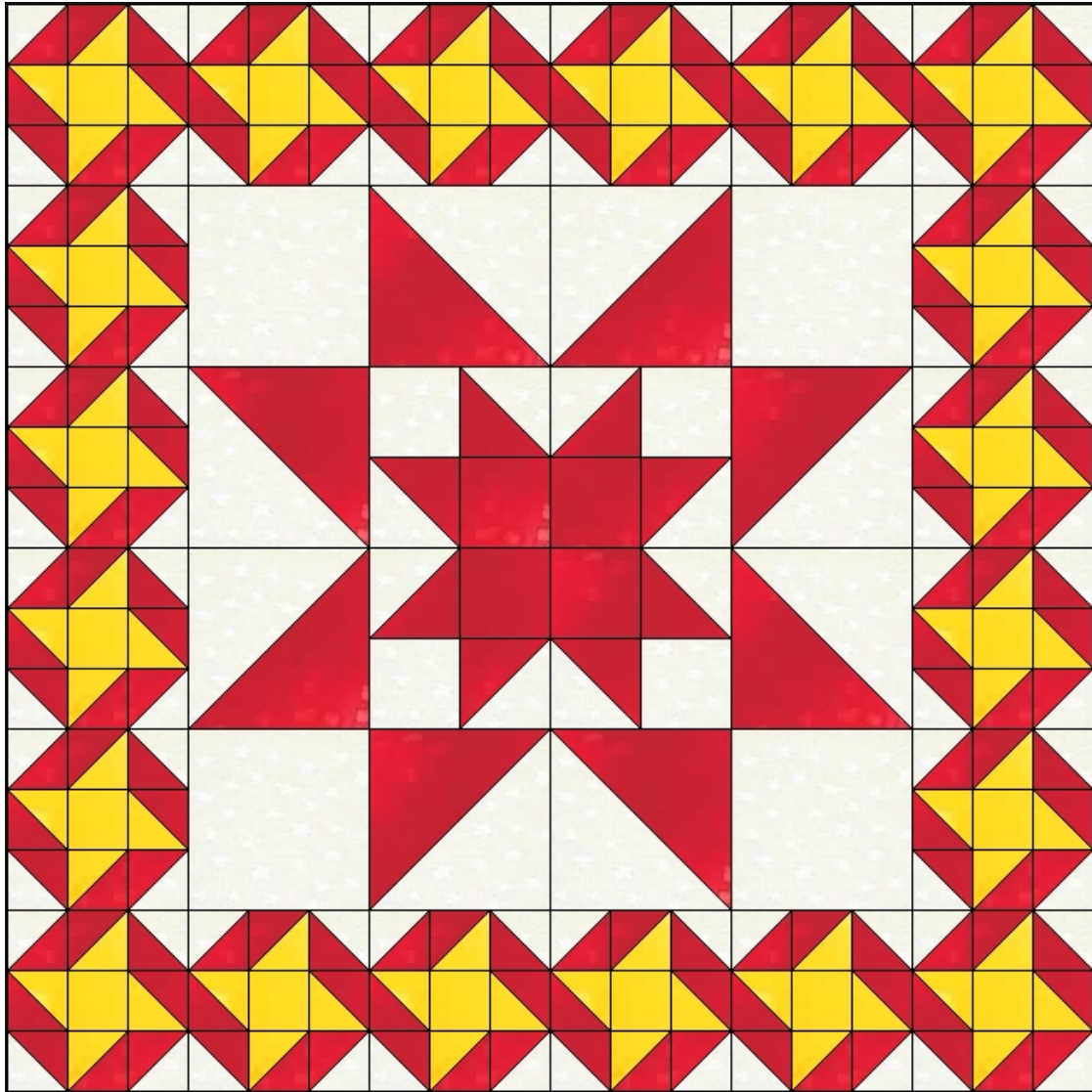
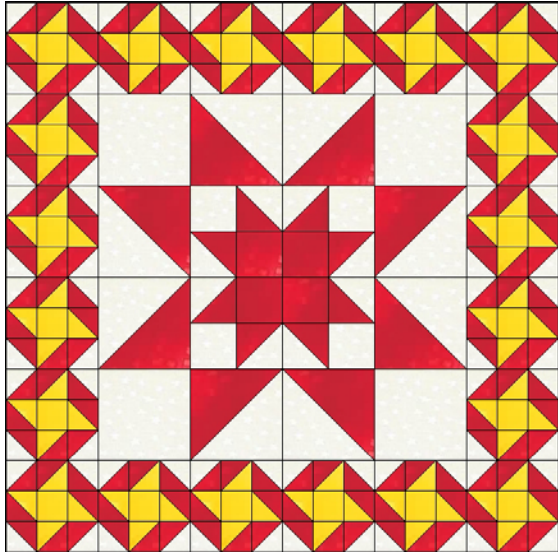


A Star For Enchie



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A Star For Enchie

Wallhanging Quilt
Block size: 6 1/2" (6" finished)
Finished Size: 36" x 36"

This pattern is very simple to create and is a great way to highlight some of your favorite quilting fabrics in a stunning setting. Designed specially for my Secret Sister, Enchie in Canada.

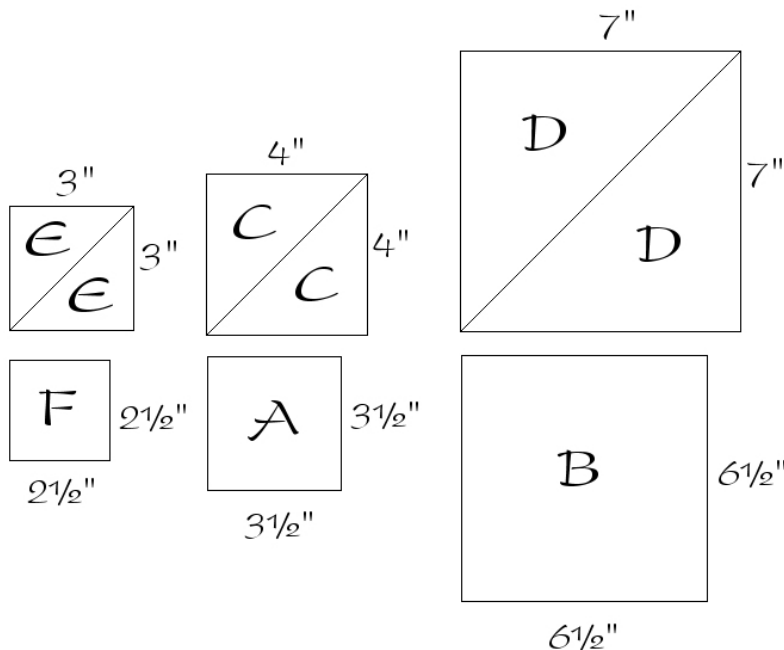
All seams should be sewn with a **scant 1/4" seam allowance**, and all seams should be pressed to one side. Press after every seam you sew to ensure your blocks are accurate.

Materials and Yardage:

Yardage requirements based on 40" wide fabric.

Yellow	1/2 yard	80 E, 20 F
White	1 1/4 yards	4 A, 4 B, 8 C, 8 D, 80 E
Red	1 1/4 yards	4 A, 8 C, 8 D, 160 E
Backing	1 1/4 yards	
Batting	Crib (45" x 60")	
Binding	1/2 yard	

Rotary Cutting Guide:

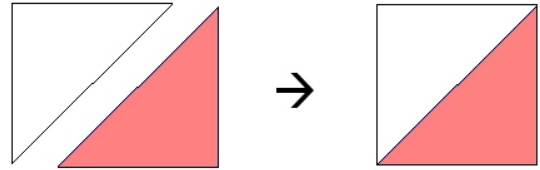


Measurements include a 1/4" seam allowance.

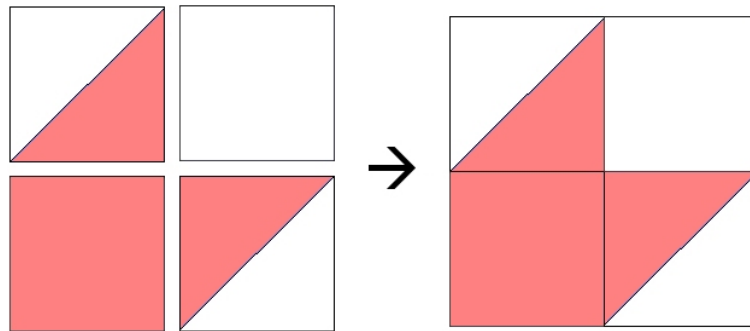
Note that this guide is only to provide a visual of what the pieces will look like once they are cut, they are not to be used as templates.

Assembly:

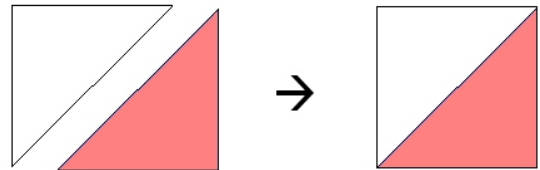
1) First, sew together a white “C” and a red “C” to make a square, sewing along the long side. Be careful when sewing and pressing a seam on the bias edge lest the fabric stretch.. Trim the square to be 3 1/2” x 3 1/2”. **Make 8 blocks.**



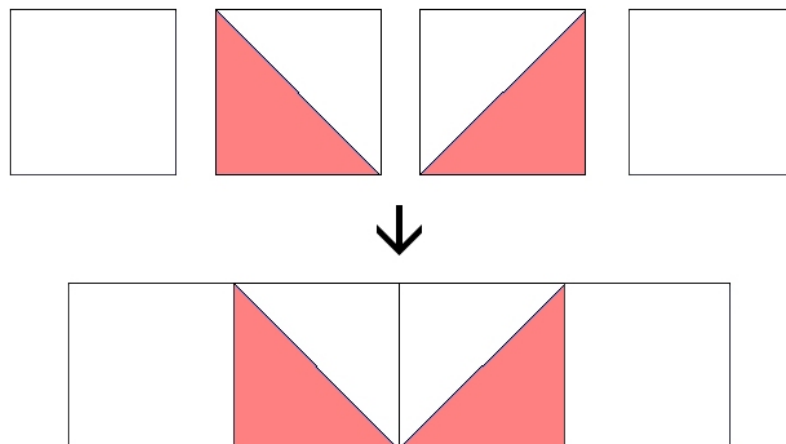
2) Assemble Block X as shown. Using two blocks from step 1, one white “A” and one red “A”, assemble the pieces into a 4-patch Block X, measuring 6 1/2” x 6 1/2”. **Make 4 of Block X.**



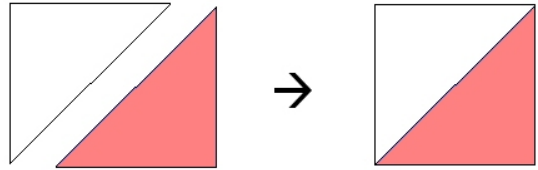
3) Assemble Block Y as shown. Sew together a white “D” and a red “D” to make a square, sewing along the long side. Be careful when sewing and pressing a seam on the bias edge lest the fabric stretch. Trim the square to be 6 1/2” x 6 1/2”. **Make 8 of Block Y.**



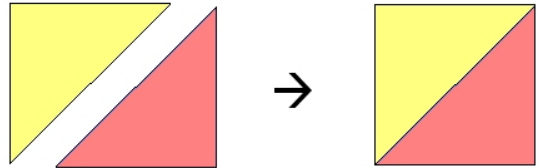
4) Assemble **two rows** with these pieces in this order: Piece “B”, Block Y, Block Y, Piece “B”.



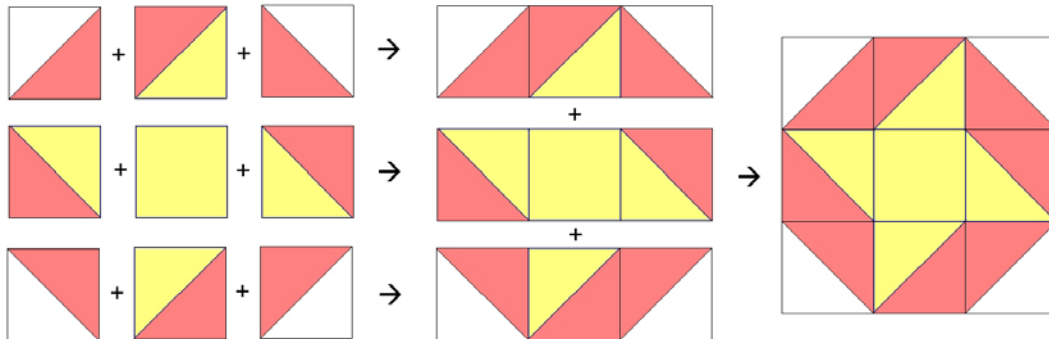
7) Sew together a white “E” and a red “E” to make a square, sewing along the long side. Trim the square to be 2 1/2” x 2 1/2”. **Make 80 blocks.**



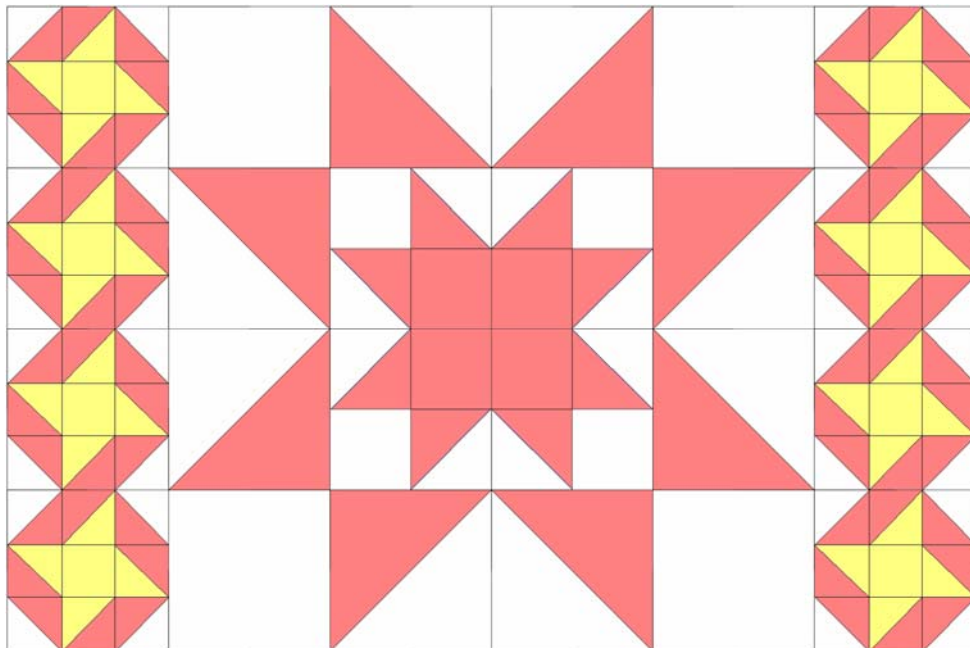
8) Sew together a yellow “E” and a red “E” to make a square, sewing along the long side. Trim the square to be 2 1/2” x 2 1/2”. **Make 80 blocks.**



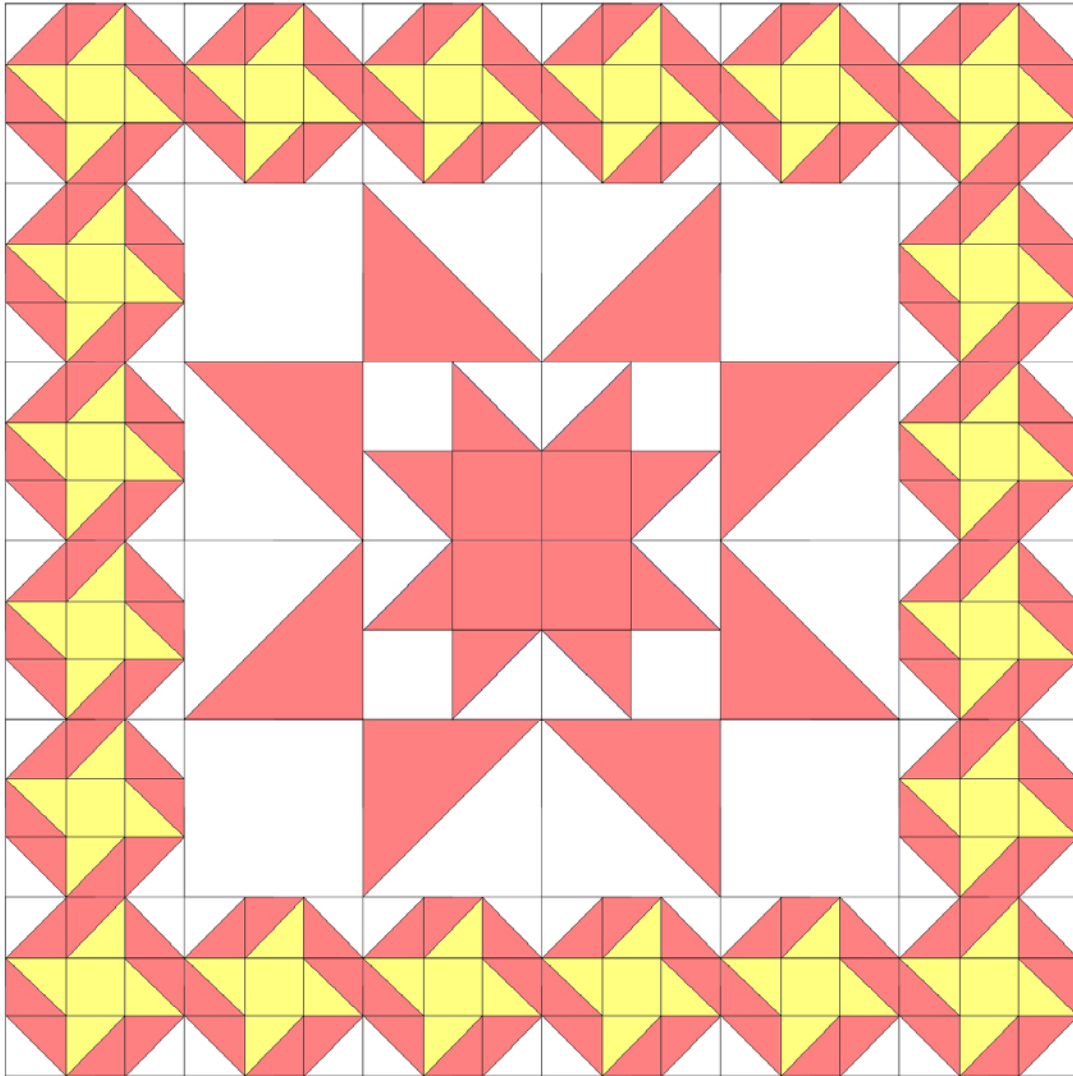
9) Assemble Block Z as shown. Using four blocks from step 7, four blocks from step 8, and one yellow “F”, assemble the pieces into a 9-patch Block Z, measuring 6 1/2” x 6 1/2”. **Make 20 of Block Z.**



10) Assemble two rows, each with four of Block Z. Attach to the sides of the medallion made in step 6.



11) Assemble two rows, each with 6 of Block Z. Attach to the top and bottom of the medallion.



12) Layer backing, batting and quilt top; baste; quilt as desired. Bind to finish.

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
