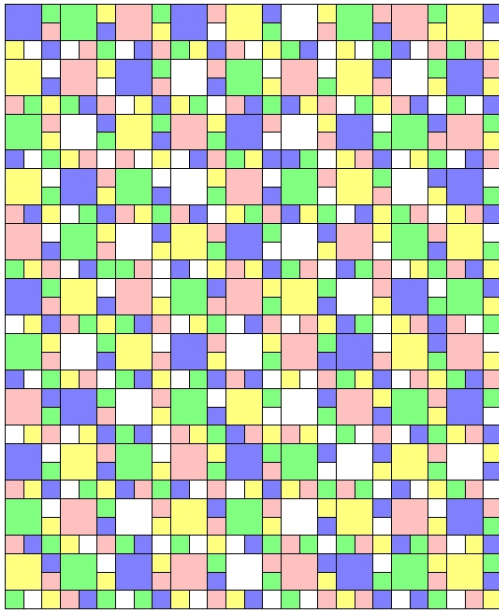

Rosy Homecoming

Cradle Quilt

Block size: 3 1/2" (3" finished)

Finished Size: 27" x 33"

This pattern is very simple to create and is a great way to use up your stash of small scraps. Make it super scrappy or use a few special fabrics!

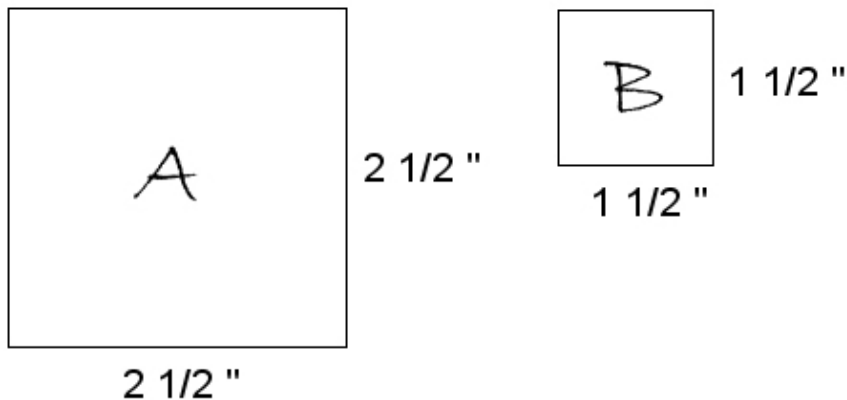
All seams should be sewn with a **scant 1/4" seam allowance**, and all seams should be pressed to one side. Press after every seam you sew to ensure your blocks are accurate.

Materials and Yardage:

Yardage requirements based on 40" wide fabric.

Material:	Yardage:	Cutting Guide:
Pink scraps	To total 3/8 yard	20 A, 100 B
Yellow scraps	To total 3/8 yard	20 A, 100 B
White-on-white scraps	To total 3/8 yard	20 A, 100 B
Blue scraps	To total 3/8 yard	20 A, 100 B
Green scraps	To total 3/8 yard	20 A, 100 B
Backing	1 1/4 yards	
Batting	Crib (45" x 60")	
Binding	1/2 yard	

Rotary Cutting Guide:

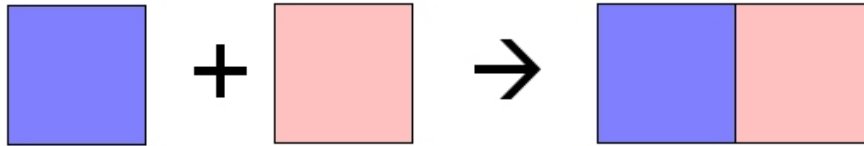


Measurements include a 1/4" seam allowance.

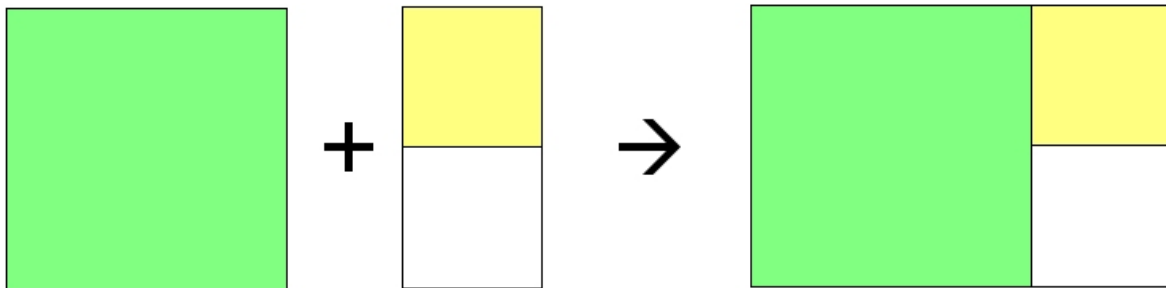
Note that this guide is only to provide a visual of what the pieces will look like once they are cut, they are not to be used as templates.

Assembly:

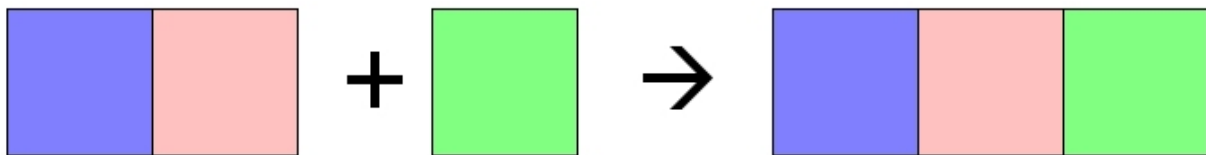
1) First, randomly pair up different colors of Block B and sew together on one side. **Make 198** of these pieces. There will be extra pieces.



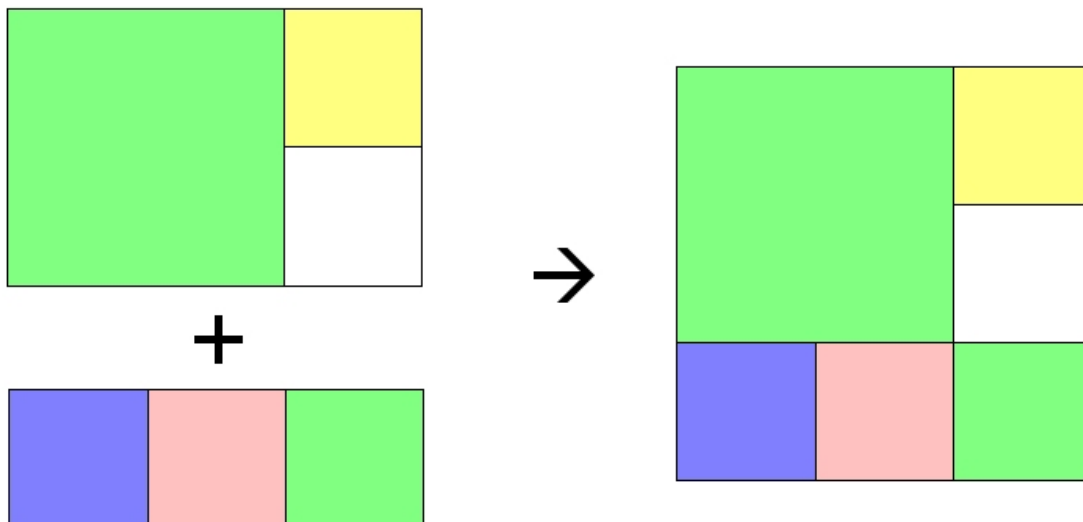
2) Pair up one of the Block B pairs with one of the Block A pieces, and sew together. **Make 99** of these pieces.



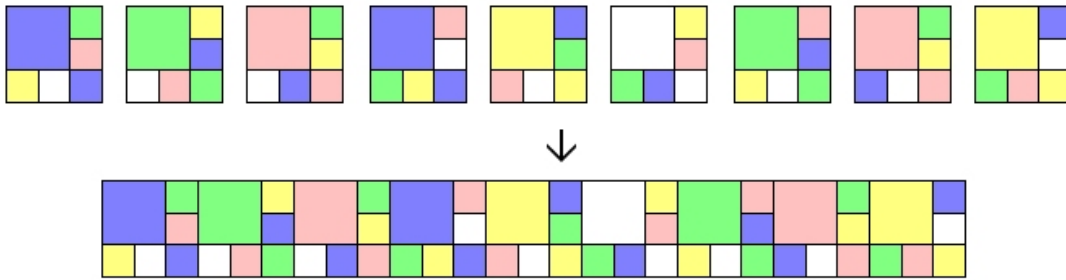
3) Pair up one of the Block B pairs with one of the remaining Block B pieces, and sew together. **Make 99** of these pieces.



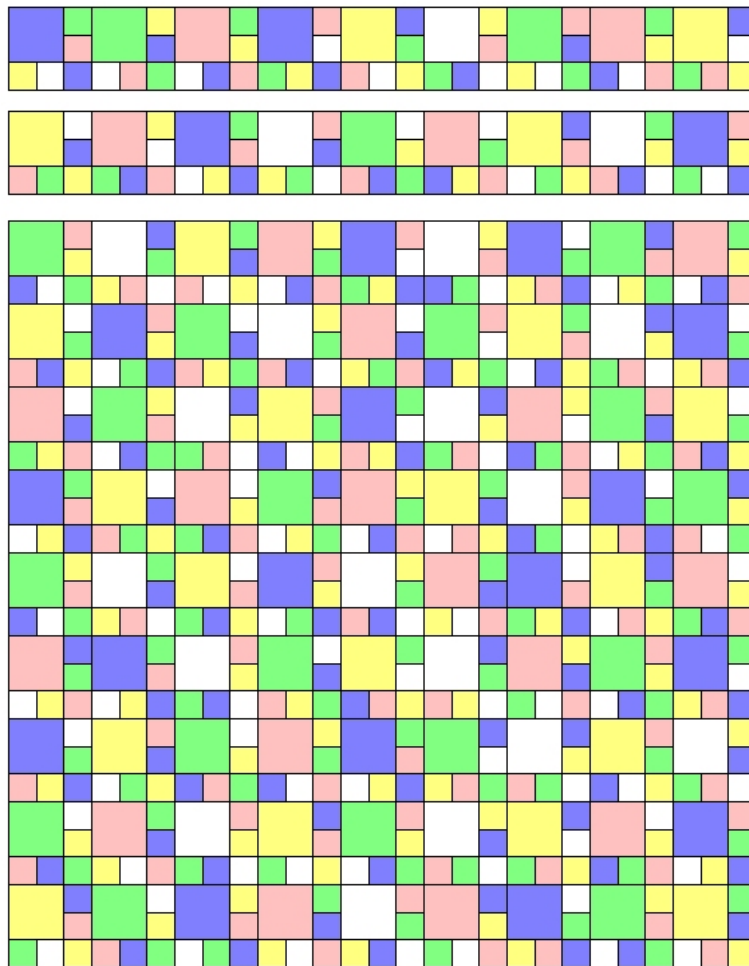
4) Pair up one piece from Step 2 with one piece from Step 3 to make a complete block. **Make 99** blocks.



5) Assemble blocks into 11 rows of 9 blocks, randomly placing the blocks to make the colors more interesting.



6) Assemble the quilt top by sewing the rows together.



7) Layer backing, batting and quilt top; baste; quilt as desired. Bind to finish.
